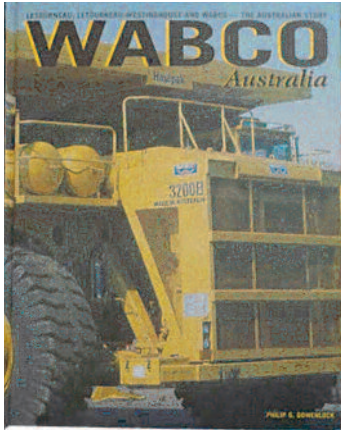
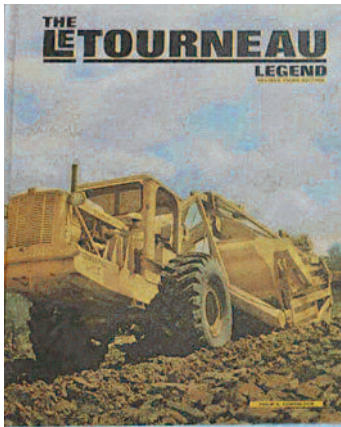


THE FOUR HEAVY EQUIPMENT BOOKS YOU MUST HAVE.

This high quality book specifically covers the history of LeTourneau, LeTourneau-Westinghouse and Wabco's extensive manufacturing and distribution operations in Australia which spanned some 43 years commencing in 1941 until 1984. A condensed company history is interwoven with a detailed technical and historical description of LeTourneau, LeTourneau-Westinghouse and Wabco equipment manufactured or assembled in Australia during that time. The development of each machine type is covered along with detailed and extensive equipment manufacturing records, serial numbers and production tables, illustrated by some 358 photographs. Wabco Australia is a high quality hard bound book of considerable technical detail. It is assumed by the author that the reader possesses a good knowledge of engineering, mechanical and earthmoving terminology.

The LeTourneau Legend is a 50-year history of American earthmoving equipment manufacturer, R.G. LeTourneau, Inc. LeTourneau's history is essentially the history of the earthmoving industry from 1920 to 1970. First published in 1995, this was the first book ever to be published covering the history of LeTourneau heavy equipment. Source and research materials includes both company and non-company materials, researched over the course of nearly two decades prior to publication. This book is considered to be the most authoritative book on the history of earthmoving equipment and has become the benchmark reference work for numerous books, magazine articles and writings by authors and writers on the subject of heavy earthmoving equipment history and methods and in particular, LeTourneau, world-wide. The LeTourneau Legend includes 314 accompanying photographs and illustrations along with production records, equipment patents and specifications. Also included are historical accounts of the involvement of key personnel who worked for the LeTourneau Company.
